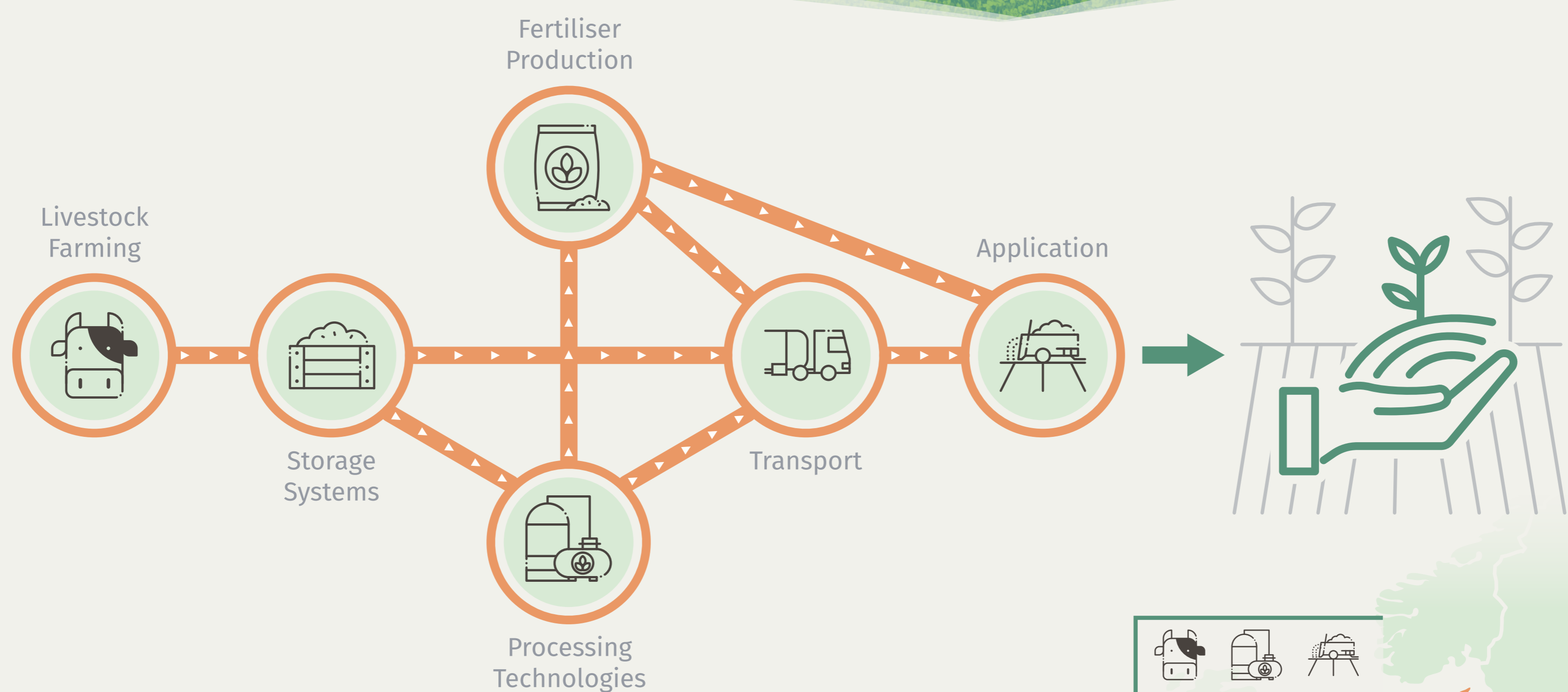


# Exchanging Easy-To-Understand Nutrient Management Knowledge With Farmers

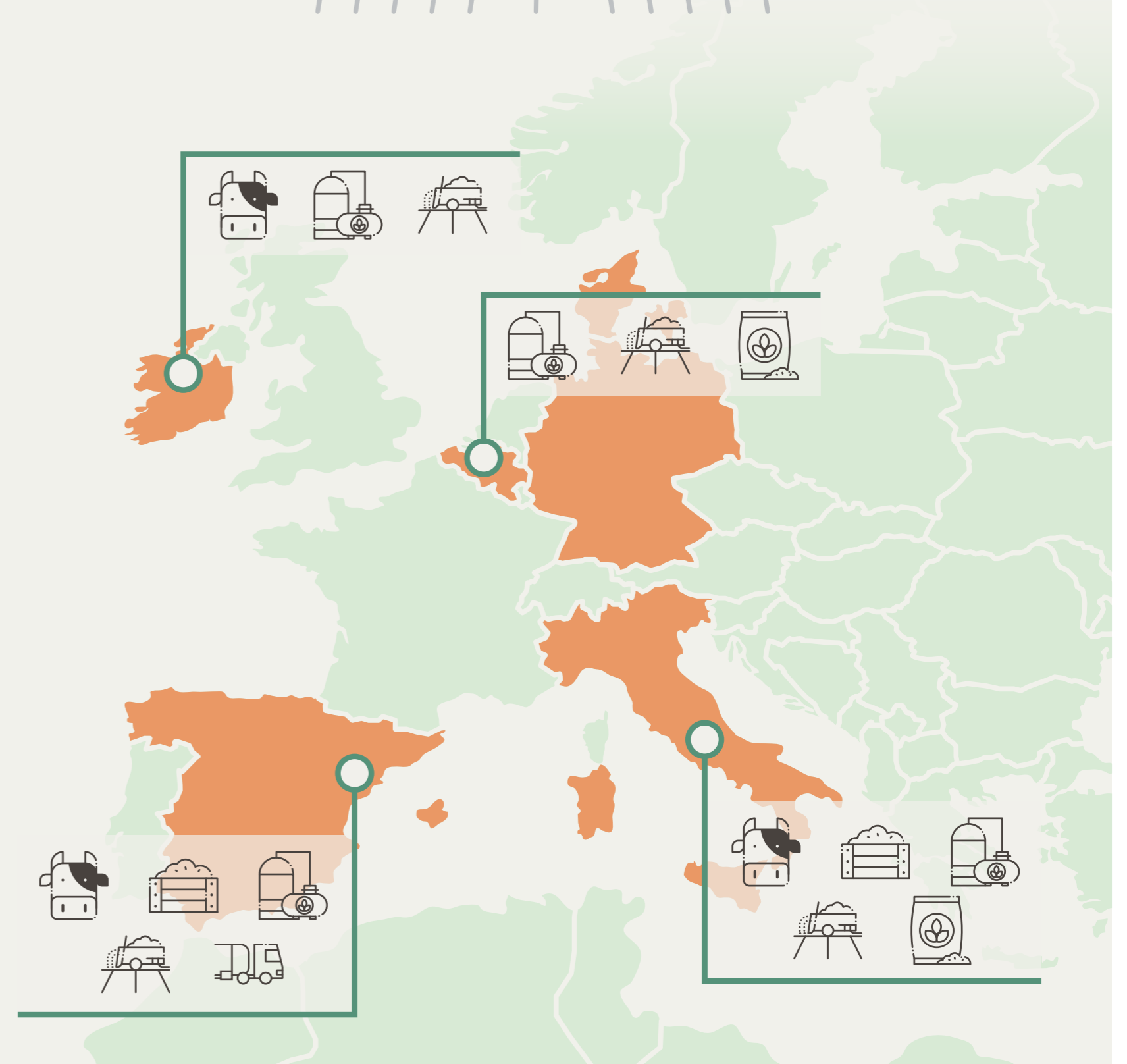


## NUTRI-KNOW Operational Groups

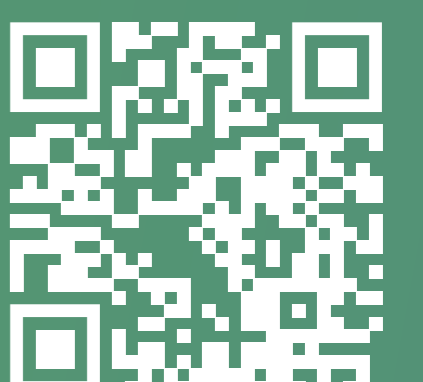
